RESOLUTION R - 4641

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST THE CITY MAY HAVE IN AN UNOPENED RIGHT-OF-WAY AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND REQUESTED BY PROPERTY OWNERS PETER AND PAULA CHRISTIANSEN

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to recognize that any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1890 as right-of-way abutting a portion of the Cormode and Adsit's First Addition to Kirkland have been vacated by operation of law; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provide that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated by operation of law at that time; and

WHEREAS, the area which is the subject of this request was annexed to the City of Kirkland, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. As requested by the property owners Peter and Paula Christiansen, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby recognizes that the following described right-of-way has been vacated by operation of law and relinquishes all interest it may have, if any, in the portion of right-of-way described as follows:

A portion of unopened right-of-way being identified as the north 30 feet of the unopened "Washington Street" abutting the south boundary of Lots 16 through 20, Block 1, Cormode and Adsit's First Addition to Kirkland, according to the plat thereof recorded in Volume 6 of Plats, page 44, records of King County, Washington.

<u>Section 2</u>. This resolution does not affect any third party rights in the property, if any.
