

RESOLUTION R-4686

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND  
APPROVING THE DESIGNATION OF THE TOTEM LAKE URBAN CENTER AS A  
GROWTH AND TRANSPORTATION EFFICIENCY CENTER (GTEC)

WHEREAS, the Totem Lake neighborhood has been designated an  
Urban Center by the Kirkland City Council and by the Growth Management  
Planning Council and is so designated in the City's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of a GTEC is to go beyond the goals of the  
commute trip reduction program and to reduce traffic congestion as well as  
develop and implement plans to reduce vehicle miles traveled per employee; and

WHEREAS, the GTEC designation qualifies the City of Kirkland to receive  
technical and measurement support from the Washington State Department of  
Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the GTEC designation enables and strengthens the City of  
Kirkland's applications for Federal, State and County funding such as the State  
GTEC program and Congestion Management and Air Quality program; and

WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Regional Council has approved designation  
of the Totem Lake GTEC,


Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of  
Kirkland that the Totem Lake Urban Center is designated as a GTEC.
